A. Description and Aim of the project

Leader of the Leaders is a new project which combines business and training areas from East Kowloon Junior Chamber (EKJC).

For more information about EKJC, please see Annex 1.

This project is a competition for students of Hong Kong's universities. This is a competition for competitors who divided into two groups and do the same task we provide. Compare the final result of each task and the higher marks/ values gaining team win. After series of tasks, the final winner who remains on the stage is our Leader of the Leaders.

Project aim

- We want to provide a platform for Hong Kong's undergraduates to learn more skills from the real business world.
- We want to assist Hong Kong's undergraduates to face the real business world before their graduation.
- We want to provide a platform for all competitors to show their ability and talent to other corporations.

B. Registration

Every applicant needs to submit their application form via e-mail.

If the applicant has questions, they can contact via e-mail.

There is an administration fee of HKD \$50 for applying this competition. There are 2 paying methods.

1. Payment can be made by a crossed cheque and payable to "East Kowloon Junior Chamber, then send the cheque to our EKJC mail box. (JCIHK Office address, see Annex 2) Please write down "payment for LOL 2010 registration fee" on the envelope and applicant's name and contact behind the cheque, so that we can keep track easily.

2. The registration fee can be made through our East Kowloon Junior Chamber HSBC current account. Our HSBC current A/C no. : 1788-4968-3001. Please make a copy of the receipt for your record and send the original receipt to EKJC mailbox. (JCIHK Office address, see Annex 2) Please write down "payment for LOL 2010 registration fee" on the envelope and applicant's name and contact behind the receipt, so that we can keep track easily.

C. The Jury and the regulation of the competition

Jury

Each task will be judged by each task's sponsor. The task's sponsor will give a brief regarding to task and inform the competitors the designated marking scheme before the task begins.

Regulation

- Each team needs to select a team leader right after the briefing section.
- During the task, all competitors should be responsible to their behaviors.
- Any illegal behaviors are prohibited. If found, the competitor will be disqualify from the competition.
- All applicants and competitors need to follow all the instructions told by the Leader of the Leaders' staffs.

D. The Training Sections

East Kowloon Junior Chamber will send all training courses or seminars' information which hold by all junior chambers in Hong Kong to all applicants via e-mail. All applicants can choose some suitable courses or seminars to attend, but not must.

During the competition before each task, EKJC or the task's sponsor will provide a short training/ talk which is related to the task for all competitors.

E. Eligibility

All current full time undergraduates of Hong Kong's Universities or colleges are eligible to submit their applications.

F. Enquiries by Participants

Participants may make enquiries regarding the details of the Competition to the Leader of the Leaders Committee by email on or before 22 May 2010. The Committee will, in response, upload supplementary information, if any, to the Competition Website. (www.ekjc.org/leaderoftheleaders.html)

G. Adjudication Guidelines

All tasks will be judged in accordance with the adjudication guidelines as interpreted by the Jury. The decisions of the Jury shall be final and binding on all parties concerned and decisions cannot be appealed against. The broad adjudication guidelines are:

- A. Addressing the objectives
- B. Creativity
- C. Feasibility & Practicality
- D. The higher marks/ values earned

H. Prizes and Results

During each task, we will have video recording and may make it into several episodes. All episodes may be broadcasted on the television or internet. And the winning team will be announced after each task.

The final winner will be announced after the final competition and may be rewarded with an internship this summer.

During the competition, all task document shall be made in English or Chinese, depends on the requirement of the task.

In the case of any discrepancy between the English version and Chinese version of the Competition Document, the English version shall prevail.

Throughout the course of the Competition, time mentioned in the Competition Document shall be Hong Kong time.

Annex 1 East Kowloon Junior Chamber information

The Birth of East Kowloon Junior Chamber

In 1979, some members from the Kowloon Jaycees, with the support of their mother chapter, grouped together with other young elites to establish a new chapter under the Junior Chamber International Hong Kong. After months of preparation, these young people formed the 'East Kowloon Jaycees'. The then Chief Justice Sir D. Roberts officiated the Charter Night and greeted the Charter President Senator Tang Chi Keung on 1st March 1980. In line with the world headquarters Junior Chamber International, the organization changed her name to "East Kowloon Junior Chamber" in 1997.

The Structure

East Kowloon Junior Chamber (EKJC) is a registered charitable organization. She is one of the 19 chapters of the Hong Kong Junior Chamber (formerly known as the Hong Kong Junior Chamber of Commerce); which the latter is affiliated to the world organization - Junior Chamber International. To run the organization, members elect their President and Executive Committee every year. The Board of Directors, chaired by The President, is responsible for the administration and general operation of the chapter.
